

- <u>Hands-On Experience</u>: Small group activity; interactive presentation; exhibit tour.

Tour Guidelines

- Please verify plans with the museum at least 1-2 weeks prior to your tour.
- Maximum Group Size= 60. We can accommodate no more than 60 people in the Museum.
- Public Bathroom and Water Bottle/Fountain available
- When climbing the mound, please walk up the steps carefully and walk down the same way.
- Do not roll down the side of the mound, use respectful behavior and safety.
- Please do not climb on or run in the exhibit area.
- Guided tours atop of the mound must be requested at registration.
- Self-Guided tours are encouraged for individual exploration.
